Inventory & Visual Merchandising Assistant

Primary Purpose

The Inventory & Visual Merchandising Assistant will assist in establishing Garden Safari Gifts as a well-managed gift shop with a strong profit margin that sells a wide range of merchandise appealing to the diverse people who visit Como Park Zoo & Conservatory (CPZC). The Inventory & Visual Merchandising Assistant is a hands-on position working closely with our buyers and staff. Primary responsibilities will include assisting in the visual merchandising and set-up of in-store displays, building of new store displays, monitoring and filling of sales floor product including seasonal locations, monitor and assist stockroom flow, entering of pre-written purchase orders and invoiced receiving's, filing of inventory paperwork, processing damages, assisting with annual physical inventory, assisting with employee scheduling and completing monthly rental reports.

Experience and Qualifications

Candidates must have a minimum of two years' experience in a specialty retail environment, with inventory management and visual presentation experience. The successful candidate must have experience developing & implementing a visual strategic plan, be able to thrive in a fast paced, multi-tasking environment with shifting priorities, be skilled in POS and other retail software proficiency including Microsoft Office and Counterpoint. Candidate must have the ability to work as part of a team and/or independently, have a strong attention to detail and a proven ability to prioritize and execute tasks effectively and efficiently, excellent interpersonal communication and customer service skills, be able to act with integrity and professionalism to ensure business is conducted without bias or prejudice, and work a non-standard/flexible schedule to meet the needs of the business, which may include weekends, evenings, holidays and closing shifts.

Job Responsibilities

- Assist Store Managers in the visual presentation of store merchandise, including implementation of the visual plan for merchandising and set-up of store displays, coordinating accessories and home accents and tracking of in-store inventory and replenishment.
- Assist Store Managers in maintaining employee schedules and completion of monthly rental reports.
- Assist Store Managers and Inventory Specialist in the input of purchase orders and invoiced receiving's.

- Assists Inventory Specialist in management of a storeroom for a high traffic retail environment, including assisting in physical receiving of merchandise, and the preparation and push of products to the sales floor in a timely manner. Ability to maintain, recover and replenish sales floor and back stock including seasonal locations.
- Assist Inventory Specialist and Managers with inventory control. Play a role in annual physical inventory preparation, physical counts and entering inventory into POS system.
- Communicate merchandise status to the buyers for reorders, cancellations and markdowns. Maintain an awareness of loss prevention policies, security and safety in the shops.
- Proficient with office equipment, including campus radio system, adding machine, telephone, copier, fax machine, postage scale and meter, laminator etc.
- Set-up and maintain fixtures using hand or power tools, such as saws, hammers, screwdrivers, staple guns, ladders, mannequins, scissors, nails, paint, spray paint, spray glue, and knives.
- Physical specifications: Constant moving, talking, hearing, reaching, grabbing and standing for at least two consecutive hours. May occasionally involve stooping, kneeling, crouching, and climbing ladders. Vision abilities include close vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. Involves lifting at least 40 lbs.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

The Inventory & Visual Assistant is supervised by the Store Manager & Assistant Manager. This is a part-time position with a competitive salary.
